Since 1975, it brings together Heads of state, top representatives of European and international institutions, cabinet ministers, business leaders, Nobel Prize winners, academics and other influential personalities from around the world, to debate the contemporary issues of great importance for the world economy and society as a whole, with the underlying mission to contribute to the growth of excellence in business and in civil society.

In a highly stimulating and private environment, participants are able to concentrate on the key contemporary issues, interact, and debate with decision makers, worldwide experts and business leaders during formal and informal discussions.

## The European House-Ambrosetti International Summit

Before the South Africa-Italy Summit – now in its fourth edition this year –, The European House-Ambrosetti has organized 5 editions of "Developing the regions of Africa and Europe". This project, aimed at reinforcing the strategic relationship between Europe and Africa, included an exclusive Forum that brought together 150 leaders from the two continents (heads of state, ministers, business leaders, Nobel Prize winners and opinion leaders) for a high-level discussion on European-African relations and business opportunities. The strategic studies presented at the Forum and the debates investigated key political, economic, and social issues for Africa and Europe, in order to identify the best areas for collaboration.

In 2017 The European House-Ambrosetti has organized the first edition of High Level Dialogue on ASEAN Italy Economic Relations and in 2016 the first edition of the Iran – Italy Summit (in November 2017 there will be the second edition). In addition, The European House – Ambrosetti has an established long-track record in business promotion and Summit organization. These include "Observatory on Europe" held annually in Bruxelles – Belgium, "Qianhai Conference" held in Qianhai in 2014, "International Credit Rating System Reform" Forum held in Hong Kong in 2013, the "World Foresight Forum" organized in The Hague-Netherlands in 2011, the "Italy-Japan Business Group" in 2010 and the "Intelligence on Chinese and European Economies" held in Lyiang, China in 2009.
