New generation of FTAs emphasizes collaboration beyond tariffs

- RCEP: customs procedures and trade facilitation, standards, technical regulations and conformity assessment, consultations etc.
- CPTPP: customs administration and trade facilitation, SPS, TBT, environment etc.
