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Digital Economy, Inclusiveness in Vietnam, and possible partnership with ASEAN countries and Italy

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"Doi Moi" – Renovation Policy since 1986

- Vietnam's socialist-oriented market economy model, with the goal of transforming Vietnam from centrally planned economy to a market economy.
- The Doi Moi policy focuses on:
 - Liberalization measures to unleash resources in society such as permanent land allocation to farmers, development of private enterprises, and promotion of trade liberalization and FDI investment attraction, creating an equal business environment among economic sectors.
 - Policies that ensure social justice, reduce inequality such as the social security system, redistribute income through a progressive personal income tax system, etc.

Achievements

- Vietnam has made many achievements in economic development and poverty reduction, hailed by UNDP as the world's success story in poverty reduction
- GDP per capita increased from \$97 in 1990 to \$1,158 in 2008, surpassing the low-income threshold to join middle-income countries, and reaching \$4,110 in 2022.
- The poverty rate fell from 58% in 1993 to a low of 4.8% 2020. Income inequality through the GINI coefficient decreased from 0.43 to 0.37
- The business environment for the private sector is increasingly improved, people have more access to public services and the level of access is more and more equal

BUT growth slowdown, due to Extensive model → needs new model based on S&T and Innovation (Intensive model)

Digital Economy in IR 4.0 & digital era

- The Party and Government's view that proactively participating in the 4th Industrial Revolution is an opportunity for Vietnam to make a breakthrough in socio-economic development
- Strategy "Make in Viet Nam" (endogenous capacity) for high-tech industries
- National Digital Transformation Program to 2025, orientation to 2030
- Project "Supporting the national innovation startup ecosystem until 2025"





Leading technology subsectors in Vietnam

Smart City

54 among 63 cities and provinces in Vietnam have been approved to develop a smart city. Among these, 10 have already formed partnerships with both local and global vendors to implement smart cities.

• Financial Technology (FinTech)

Vietnam's FinTech market size is anticipated to hit 18 billion USD by 2024 (According to a representative of Robocash Group).

• Education Technology (EdTech)

Vietnam's EdTech market is estimated to reach 3 billion USD in 2023.

Cybersecurity

According to Statista, revenue in the Vietnam cybersecurity market is projected to reach **269.1 million USD** in **2023**

Telecommunications

The Vietnam telecom services market size was valued at \$6.3 billion in 2022.

→ HIGH DEMAND FOR ICT PRODUCTS & SERVIES, SOLUTIONS

Inclusiveness

- At national level
 - Help disadvantaged groups (SMEs, disadvantaged people: disables, in remote, difficult areas) connect to support, services, opportunities
 - In the context of fragmentation, broken supply chains, digitalization helps to ensure connectivity
- At regional level
 - Help less developed countries catch-up
 - Meet each other's digital demand (complementarity)

HOWEVER,

Prospects for cooperation with ASEAN countries & Italy

- Cooperation framework: AEC; ASEAN Digital Masterplan 2025
- Cooperation domains
 - Connectivity
 - Infrastructure development
 - Cybersecurity assurance
 - Data science
 - Human capital development

- The ICT sector is playing an increasingly strategic role in Italy
- Remarkable growth rates for most segments of the ICT market (75 bln euro in 2021): Cloud, Blockchain, Cybersecurity, Big Data, and AI
- → Potentials for cooperation with ASEAN countries and Vietnam on ICT sector
