### **Maurizio Ghirga**

Maurizio Ghirga is Executive Director of the Asian Development Bank for Belgium, France, Italy, Portugal, Spain, and Switzerland.

Prior to joining ADB, he worked for the Bank of Italy for 27 years. At the same time, he was a member of the Market Operations Committee of the European Central Bank.

At the Bank of Italy he was the Director and Head of Investment Division, responsible for the investment of foreign exchange reserves, own euro funds, and Pension Fund from 2008 until 2014. In April 1999, he became Senior Portfolio Manager at the Financial Investment Directorate. He was Senior Official at the International Relations Department in Rome, from July 1997 to March 1999. He was assigned to Tokyo, Japan as Deputy Delegate in the Bank of Italy's Representative Office from 1992 to 1997. He became Bank Official at the Treasury Liaison Department in 1987.

Before joining the Bank of Italy, he was Financial Analyst at CREDIOP's Finance Department.

Maurizio Ghirga graduated in Economics from the University of Rome, Italy, in 1982.
