



BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

MARCO ARZILLI

Marco Arzilli has been the Secretary of State for Industry, Handicraft and Trade of the Republic of San Marino since December 2008. On December 2012, with the establishment of the Government of the XXVIII legislature, has been reappointed Secretary of State for Industry, Handicraft and Trade, with the addition of proxies for Transport and Technological Research.

As Minister of Industry, since 2009, he is a member of the Committee for Credit and Savings and Governor of the World Bank for San Marino.

Until 2008 he held the position of Chief Executive Officer of "G. Arzilli S.p.A.", the commercial family enterprise operating in the field of jewelry.

After being active in the Christian Democratic Party, in 2006 Marco Arzilli was a founding member of a new Political Movement called "*Noi Sammarinesi*". Elected for the first time in Great and General Council (Parliament) for the 2006-2008 term, he became a member of the Foreign Affairs Committee, Institutional Affairs and Justice, Finance, Social Security and Environment and the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU: International organization of Parliaments of sovereign States).

During the short term he has been promoting on behalf of the movement of "*Noi Sammarinesi*" different initiatives, including intervention against the vote exchange and supporting the obligation for candidates in the general election, to submit their tax return and equity investments.

In the elections of November 2008, Marco Arzilli founded, along with the movement "*Noi Sammarinesi*" and the New Socialist Party, the "*List of Liberty*", part of the coalition pact for San Marino in which he was elected. In the elections of November 2012 he is a candidate still in the ranks of the Movement "*Noi Sammarinesi*" and he has been elected in the list with the Christian Democratic Party in the coalition "*San Marino Bene Comune*", who won the election.

From 2002 to 2008 Marco Arzilli was President of the San Marino Trade and Tourism (USC). In 2007 he was among the founders of Lilliput Club, club that has, among its objectives, the promotion of cooperation between small States.

Born in San Marino in 1971, he is married with two children.
