



Dedicated projects

Careers and Competences - increasing the adjustment of the vocational education system to the needs of the labor market based on the K2 Network in the central subregion of the Silesian Voivodeship (465 students, 83 teachers, 11 schools, project value PLN 7.5 million);

Dual Studies at the University of Technology - Faculty of Mechanical Engineering - Mechanics and Machine Design, so far 60 students, 50% of practical studies, PLN 400scholarship, PLN 2000salary;

Innovator Club - club for innovators, creative, young people and students; an educational and training platform for the exchange of knowledge & experience gained through the success stories of high-achievers;

The Polish-German Center for Hybrid Lightweight Structures - Katowice SEZ, Silesian University of Technology and German technical universities from Dresden and Freiberg - project concerns intensification of cooperation in the field of composites, including conducting joint scientific research and establishing faculties, as well as commercialization of research results;

Center of Excellence in Plastics Injection – under development;

Silesian Competence Center for Industry 4.0 – aims at supporting regional companies in digital transformation.






Percentage share of sectors in the total investments





Polish Investment Zone-new regulations

- Departure from the territorial limit of the SEZ "entire Poland as a zone,"
- Issuing administrative decisions (state aid) for a definite period (10-15 years)
- Acceleration of procedures for granting state aid (no need to time-consuming assigning SEZ status to new areas)
