Written Statement by European Commissioner Mariya Gabriel

Value of Sport Observatory Forum Rome, 25 January 2023



Dear Ministers.

Ladies and gentlemen,

I can't be there with you today, but I couldn't miss this chance to address you today at this Forum, marking the end of a successful first year for The European House Ambrosetti **Value of Sport Observatory**.

This Observatory is precisely the kind of initiative we need: a platform created to disseminate knowledge and raise awareness of the importance of sport for **people**, their **communities** and the **economy in Italy**, and beyond.

As you gather in Rome today, I cannot help but think of the **very first Summer Paralympic Games** and **Italy's first Summer Olympic Games**, held within the walls of this stadium, back in 1960. Historic moments like these are of great cultural significance for the people of Italy and for our European community.

Their memories evoke key traits of our **European Sport Model**, such as openness, inclusion and solidarity. And they remind us of the importance of sport in promoting and upholding our **European values**. It would not be an exaggeration to say that sport is part of the very fabric of our societies and a hallmark of our **European way of life**.

This is why during the 2021-2027 period, the EU will provide **470 million euros** through **Erasmus+** to support projects, learning mobility and events promoting our shared values through sport.

One example is the project 'Autism and Sport: Train Social Inclusion', which received a grant of 400,000 euros of EU funding to strengthen the inclusion of

people with autism spectrum disorders in sport. Activities such as these are a testament to our community's commitment to our shared values.

These actions also have a key role to play in empowering our community to overcome **common challenges**, such as the green and digital transitions in our societies. Another key challenge we currently face is a wave of **inactivity** exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic, posing a serious risk to people's **physical** and **mental health**.

To address this issue and encourage people of all ages to become more physically active, in 2021 I launched the **HealthyLifestyle4All campaign**. As a result, around 100 organisations have already pledged to deliver activities promoting active healthy lifestyles. This is a strong start. But we need to keep going. And your participation in joining this community will be welcomed!

For example, during the pandemic, our young people disproportionately suffered the effects of COVID-19, in particular for their mental health. To help find innovative solutions to these and other challenges, last year I initiated the **HealthyLifeStyle4AII Youth Ideas Labs**, as a genuine concrete example of our European Year of Youth. This year, we will empower these Labs, as a clear legacy of the EYY 2022.

Only by working together, giving all members of our community a voice, will we be able to harness the transformative power of sport in our societies.

I am therefore delighted to see members of our sport community coming together at events like today's Forum to discuss how to deepen our cooperation and exchange ideas.

I trust that the **Value of Sport of Observatory** will continue to make a strong contribution to this noble pursuit. I wish you all fruitful discussions throughout today's event and every success your future endeavours to raise awareness of the importance of sport for **people** and their **communities**.
